



# ACCESSIBILITY GUIDE

We are committed to ensuring all our guests are able to enjoy their Goodwood Revival experience and we've gathered some key information around accessibility at the event.

We have a range of dedicated facilities across the event site designed to meet the needs of visitors with impaired mobility, enabling you to catch all the action and experience the event to the full.

## TRAVEL AND PARKING

### ROAD SIGNS

On nearing the event, standard yellow event road signs marked with a disabled symbol will direct you to a dedicated parking area.

### CAR PARKS

Accessible parking will be available at the front of each car park. Please ensure you have your blue badge on display. Courtesy vehicles will be on hand in all public car parks to give assistance to those unable to walk to the event entrances.

Electric scooter chairs are available for hire from Shopmobility – it is essential to pre-book with Shopmobility on 01329 287749 or online at [www.shop.cfirst.org.uk/goodwood-shopmobility](http://www.shop.cfirst.org.uk/goodwood-shopmobility). They will be based in Car Park D.

Shopmobility will be based in Car Park D opposite the event entrance at Gate 12.

Please be aware that parts of the event are uneven and on grass, therefore an electric wheelchair may be easier to navigate around the event.

### COURTESY SHUTTLE SERVICE

A free courtesy shuttle service for disabled guests operates on a priority basis from all public car parks to the event entrance. Please wait by the courtesy shuttle signs for assistance.

The courtesy car service operates in reverse for departure from the Gate 13 Taxi Office. The service operates between 0730hrs until 1900hrs.

### SHOPMOBILITY

Electric and manual wheelchairs are available to hire from event Shopmobility and must be booked in advance of the event by calling 01329 287749. Shopmobility are based in Car Park D, our accessible car park, and is open from 0730hrs until 1900hrs.

# ON-EVENT FACILITIES

## TRACK VIEWING

There are five disabled viewing platforms, three of which are covered, located in the following locations:

- South of the March Enclosure
- Chicane Infield
- Madgwick Corner
- Startline (not covered)
- Lavant Straight

## TOILETS

Accessible toilet facilities are located across site. Please visit the large 'you are here' maps for exact locations. Mobiloo toilet facilities are available on Supershell Lawn. Mobiloo facilities include a toilet, electric hoist and adult-sized changing bench.

## CAMPING

Campsite H is equipped with accessible toilet and shower facilities.

Dedicated shuttles will run frequently from Campsite H to the main Revival site.

## GETTING AROUND GOODWOOD REVIVAL

A fleet of period vehicles operate within the event to assist guests with mobility issues in getting around the site. Please be advised that not all vehicles meet modern standards with regard to restraint and access, and won't be suitable for all mobility needs. This single-journey service works on a priority basis, and may be subject to delays. Vehicles can be requested from Shopmobility in Car Park D, Gate 2A Taxi Office or Gate 13 Taxi Office.

## FIRST AID

There is an on-site pharmacy providing medicines, toiletries, suntan lotion, earplugs and sunglasses, located behind the Chicane Grandstand, close to the Revival Market. There are also numerous first aid sites located around the Revival staffed by qualified doctors and medical staff.

You can find treatment centres Over the Road by the bridge, at Lavant Corner, and by the airside barrier between Earls Court Motor Show and the Tony Gaze Building.
