

Blink and you'll miss it! Brabham BT52 to return to Goodwood for 80th Members' Meeting demonstration

- 80th Members' Meeting presented by Audrain Motorsport to host on-track demonstration of the Brabham-BMW BT52
- The BT52 is at the centre of a Goodwood legend - allegedly recording the Circuit's first sub-minute lap in 1983
- 80th Members' Meeting will take place Saturday 15 - Sunday 16 April

Famously known for being the first turbocharged F1 car to win the drivers' world championship, the Brabham-BMW BT52 will return to Goodwood at the 80th Members' Meeting presented by Audrain Motorsport. The car will be reunited with its designer Professor Gordon Murray and team manager Herbie Blash for the special on-track demonstration, which will take place across the weekend.

Although the Motor Circuit closed its doors to competitive racing in 1966, it continued to host some of the world's top teams and manufacturers as they tested their latest and greatest cars. 1983 saw the Brabham Formula One Team test its new BMW-powered BT52 with Nelson Piquet behind the wheel. Whilst no official record exists, legend has it that the BT52 lapped in under a minute, setting what was, and remains, Goodwood's fastest known lap.

Goodwood is delighted to welcome the return of the Brabham BT52 and pay homage to "the greatest lap of Goodwood" as we honour the Testing Years as part of the ongoing celebrations of Goodwood's 75-year motorsport heritage.
