



Goodwood Motor Circuit 'Covid Secure' Experience Measures

Goodwood Track Day Measures

1. Drivers should proceed straight to the paddocks area to park and maintain social distancing whilst preparing their cars
2. The sign-on desk will be positioned so attendees can sign-on without needing to enter the Jackie Stewart Pavilion. Sign on will be contact-free with all guests asked to pre-register via the pre-registration email they will receive before their visit. If you have not pre-registered before your arrival, you will be asked to stand aside to complete the link digitally, making the sign-on process longer.
3. All briefings will take place outside, either in front of the Pit Lane Office or under the pit lane, depending on the weather.
4. Toilets for guests will be available by the Richmond Lawn. Toilets are thoroughly cleaned before each day commencing and throughout each day.
5. All communal areas are cleaned thoroughly before the attendee's arrival and throughout the day. Please do not move the furniture from where it has been positioned.
6. Passengers from the same household or support bubble are permitted. Passengers who do not meet these criteria are currently not allowed.
7. Car helmets are available for hire. They will be provided with cleaning equipment and a disposable helmet liner; however, attendees are strongly encouraged to bring their own helmet if possible.
8. Multiple drivers can use one track vehicle provided attendees follow current guidelines on vehicle cleaning between drivers.
9. Social distancing must be maintained at all times to ensure the safety of all guests and staff at Goodwood Motor Circuit.

Spin & Slide Measures

1. Drivers and visitors should enter Goodwood Motor Circuit via the main entrance on Claypit Lane and proceed directly under the tunnel.
2. Drivers should proceed straight to the paddocks and park their vehicle in any available paddock shelter.

3. Sign on will be contact-free with all guests asked to pre-register online via the pre-registration email sent before their experience.
4. All briefings will take place outside where possible.
5. Toilets for guests will be available. Toilets are thoroughly cleaned before each day commencing and throughout each day.
6. All communal areas will be cleaned thoroughly before the attendee's arrival and throughout the day.
7. Guests and instructors must wear face coverings at all times whilst in vehicles together. Please do bring your own face covering. One can be supplied if required.
8. Vehicles will be cleaned thoroughly between each driver by a member of staff using antibacterial wipes.

Performance Track, Performance Hot Lap and ARDS Test Measures

1. Drivers and visitors should enter Goodwood Motor Circuit via the main entrance on Claypit Lane and proceed directly under the tunnel.
2. Drivers/passengers should proceed straight to the paddocks and park their vehicle in any available paddock shelter.
3. Sign on will be contact-free with all guests asked to pre-register online via the pre-registration email sent before their experience.
4. All briefings will take place outside where possible.
5. Toilets for guests will be available. Toilets are thoroughly cleaned before each day commencing and throughout each day.
6. All communal areas will be cleaned thoroughly prior to the attendee's arrival and throughout the day.
7. Guests and instructors must wear face coverings at all times whilst in vehicles together. Please do bring your own face covering. One can be supplied if required.
8. Vehicles will be cleaned thoroughly between each driver by a member of staff using antibacterial wipes.
9. Helmets must be used whilst on Circuit. Helmets will be cleaned between each use, and a disposable helmet liner must be worn at all times. Guests are encouraged to bring their own if possible.
10. Your instructor will retain your SD card until the end of your experience, at which point it will be cleaned thoroughly and handed to you.

11. Social distancing must be maintained at all times to ensure the safety of all guests and staff at Goodwood Motor Circuit.

Young Driver Learner & Graduation Measures

1. Drivers and visitors should enter Goodwood Motor Circuit via the main entrance on Claypit Lane.
2. Drivers should proceed straight to their allotted parking area. For the Learner Experience, take a right before the tunnel into the Chicane Paddock and park in the area directly ahead. The Graduation Experiences should proceed under the tunnel and straight to the paddocks. Parking is available in any paddock shelter.
3. Sign on will be contact-free with all guests asked to pre-register online via the pre-registration email sent before each experience.
4. All briefings will take place outside where possible.
5. Toilets for guests will be available. Toilets are thoroughly cleaned before each day commencing and throughout each day.
6. All communal areas will be cleaned thoroughly prior to the attendee's arrival and throughout the day.
7. One vehicle per guest will be allowed on-site to watch each experience.
8. Guests and instructors must wear face coverings at all times whilst in vehicles together. Please do bring your own face covering. One can be supplied if required.
9. Vehicles will be cleaned thoroughly between each driver by a member of staff using antibacterial wipes.
10. Social distancing must be maintained at all times to ensure the safety of all guests and staff at Goodwood Motor Circuit.

The Goodwood Off-Road Experience
