

TERMS AND CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO THE 2026 BREAKFAST CLUB GOODWOOD CLASSIC SOLUTIONS PRIZE DRAW

The terms and conditions set out in this section apply to all of the prize draws and competitions operated by the Goodwood Group. Additional Terms and Conditions are included in Section 2.

1. WHO IS PROMOTING/SPONSORING THIS PRIZE DRAW?

2. CAN I ENTER?
