



Derived from 'Auto Tests' AutoSOLOs are a form of competitive motorsport that are all about having fun. Drivers must manoeuvre a standard road car as quickly as possible around a course marked out by a series of numbered cones. Each competitor has three runs of each of the four courses, with their best two times submitted. Watch out for the cones though, and expect penalties for touching the grass, hitting a cone, or going the wrong way on the course!

Following overwhelming interest, we successfully doubled the number of competitors able to take part in 2019, and will be continuing with this format in 2020.

New for 2020: Motorsport UK have amended their regulations and now require all entrants to have a RS Clubman licence. The licences are free of charge, please head to motorsportuk.org to apply.

Nestled in the South Downs, our challenging circuit is an ex-military airfield. RAF Westhampnett served as a Battle of Britain base during the Second World War and was the station from which RAF legend Sir Douglas Bader flew his last sortie. The circuit originally opened its gates to the public in September 1948, to host Britain's very first post-war motor race meeting. Exactly 50 years later, the 9th Duke's grandson and the present Duke of Richmond re-enacted the opening of the track with the very first Goodwood Revival meeting on 18th September 1998, in the same Bristol 400 that his grandfather had driven half a century earlier.

Since that time the circuit has been a hive of activity and our Track Day events are always a popular day for members. These have been developed to test you and your car's ability on a track within a safe, controlled and fun environment. Our Chief Instructor is always on hand to provide some wise words of advice.

If you've never been on track, why not try our August date where we will have additional instructors on hand to offer guidance. If you would like a quieter day, then join us for our July day where numbers are limited and track time maximised.




DETAILING DAY



78TH MEMBERS' MEETING


Join us at Goodwood Motor Circuit for a weekend of historic motorsport, available to 'those who are part of Goodwood Road Racing Club'.

Goodwood's motorsport opening weekend recreates the atmosphere and camaraderie of the original BARC Meetings held at Goodwood through the 1950s and 1960s. 
