



ACCESSIBILITY GUIDE

We are committed to ensuring all our visitors are able to enjoy their Festival of Speed experience. Below we have gathered some key information around accessibility.

We have a range of dedicated facilities across the event site especially designed to meet the needs of visitors with impaired mobility, enabling you to catch all the action and experience the event to the full.

Please be aware that the event is situated on a gradient and an electric wheelchair may be easier to navigate around the event.

TRAVEL AND PARKING

ROAD SIGNS

On approaching the event site, standard yellow road signs, marked with the symbol for disabled visitors, will direct you to the dedicated disabled car parks.

CAR PARKS

We have disabled parking at the front of all our public car parks, please display your blue badge and you'll be directed there. If you are worried about accessibility, you can also pre-book our dedicated disabled parking field (Car Park U near the Goodwood Hotel) by contacting the Customer Sales on 01243 755055 who will issue a car label that you will need to gain access.

There are courtesy shuttles in all car parks to give assistance to those unable to walk to the event entrances; they will drop you at Event Gate 1.

COURTESY SHUTTLE SERVICE

A courtesy shuttle service for disabled guests operates on a priority basis from each car park to the nearest event pedestrian entrance. Please wait by the Disabled Courtesy Shuttle signs (located within each car park) for assistance.

If you require a courtesy shuttle direct to Shopmobility, we suggest you access the site from the A27 direction (into Car Park A), which is where the quickest courtesy shuttle to Shopmobility will operate from. This service operates in the reverse for departure.

SHOPMOBILITY

Electric and manual wheelchairs are available to hire from Shopmobility, which is based at Gate 1.

ON-EVENT FACILITIES

TRACK VIEWING

There are two dedicated raised viewing platforms. One is located next to the Kinrara Enclosure opposite Goodwood House; the other is situated alongside the Thakeham Family Area. Both of these viewing platforms have battery re-charging facilities for motorised wheelchairs. Please note that access onto the disabled viewing platforms require a disabled swing badge. To obtain, please call customer sales on 01243 755055.

There is also wheelchair access and space undercover within the Pheasantry Grandstand, and tickets for this grandstand can be purchased from Customer Sales on 01243 755055, subject to availability.

Personal assistant tickets for Grandstands are complimentary.

TOILETS

Disabled toilets and a Mobiloo are available and will be highlighted on the Goodwood Motorsport App and visitor guide map.

FIRST AID

There are Treatment Centres and a pharmacy on site. Please see the event map for details of the locations. There are several doctors on call throughout the event site; they can be contacted at the Treatment Centres, or via any Goodwood staff member.

CAMPING

The campsites are equipped with disabled facilities.

New for 2019, we have introduced a designated area for those with disabilities making it easier to camp at the event and making the experience as comfortable as possible. To book a pitch contact our Customer Sales team on 01243 755055. Excludes glamping options.

FOREST RALLY STAGE

To visit the Rally Stage, head to Gate 1 paylane and speak to the supervisor who can arrange for a shuttle to transport you up to the Rally Stage. To return to the main site, speak to the supervisor on the Rally Stage paylane.

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
