## OVERVIEW ITINERARY

The GRRC are delighted to be returning to the Isle of Man in the autumn of 2022, embarking on our three-night driving tour – The TTs Treasure Island. This trip has been created to provide members and their guests with a memorable and exclusive opportunity to drive the stunning roads in the North Pennines, Yorkshire Dales and of course the unmatched roads of the Isle of Man. In addition to the fabulous driving roads, we will be staying in 4\* and 5\* hotels situated in some breathtaking locations along the route. We start the trip with a night of luxury in The Rockliffe Hall hotel which boasts a beautiful 365-acre estate on the doorstep of the North Pennines national park. This offers an ideal starting point to explore some of the most remote and unspoilt roads in England before heading to the port of Heysham to cross the Irish sea, heading to the home of the famed Tourist Trophy. The Comis Hotel and Golf resort will be our base on the island offering an ideal starting point from which to explore. This tour is going to be a breathtaking mix of thrilling driving, beautiful scenery and fantastic opportunity to meet likeminded members.

### PACKAGE

Our package includes:

- Return ferry crossing with Steam Packet ferries for 2 people and one car
- 3 nights' accommodation in a range of 4\* and 5\* hotels
- Breakfast daily
- Evening meals including wine
- Overnight parking for all cars
- Printed route book including a full itinerary, driving directions and suggested places to visit
- Satellite navigation units
- Personnel to assist all members
- Support vehicles for transporting luggage and spare parts (limited availability)
- VAT and all local taxes

The price excludes anything not expressly included in the Package as well as the following:

- Motorway tolls
- Medical & travel insurance
- All lunchtime meals
- Fuel
- Any mechanical assistance with your car during the tour
- Vehicle insurance
- Alcohol (save for the allowances included with evening meals)
- Incidental extras such as use of the mini bar, spa treatments and room service.

### DAY ONE

We kick off our trip with an unforgettable dining experience and welcome dinner at the Rockliffe Hall Hotel, located just outside of Durham. This quintessentially English estate offers a range of activities including one of the largest spas in the country, an 18-hole championship golf course and spectacular grounds. Members are invited to arrive at their leisure with plenty of time ahead of our private welcome dinner, where you will have the opportunity to meet both the Goodwood team and other members joining you on this trip.

### DAY TWO

Durham to Isle of Man

Expected driving time: 3hrs 30 mins

Ferry Crossing: 2hrs 45 mins

Expected driving distance: 128 miles

Following departure from the Rockliffe Hall Hotel we have curated a route which will explore the exhilarating roads through the North Pennines and Yorkshire Dales before heading towards Heysham port where we board the ferry to cross to the Isle of Man. Once we arrive, we will head towards The Comis Hotel, our base for the next two nights. The Comis is a 4\* hotel and golf resort set in 200 acres of beautiful grounds and is surrounded beautiful views of the Island. All members and their guests will come together to toast the first night on the island and enjoy dinner at the hotel.



## DAY THREE

Scenic Tour of the Isle of Man

Expected driving time: 6 hrs

Expected driving distance: 190 miles

Today members have the opportunity to take to the treasured roads of the Isle of Man. We have created a route which explores the entire island from East to West, including the famous TT route. The island comprises of moorlands, hill tops, rivers, lakes and of course stunning coastal roads that boast beautiful views onto the Irish Sea. This is a day filled with thrilling driving but also plenty of pit stops to take a break from the adrenaline. With an eclectic mix of what this island has to offer this will certainly be one not to forget. In the evening we will meet for our final group dinner and toast a glass to a spectacular day's driving.

## DAY FOUR

Tourist Trophy- Liverpool

Expected driving time: 1hr 45mins

Ferry Crossing: 2hrs 45 mins

Expected driving distance: 41 miles

Before departing the Isle of Man, we will set off early for one final blast around the TT route before heading to the ferry port where we will cross back to the mainland and into Liverpool. From Liverpool the trip concludes, however the GRRC team will include an optional scenic route back to the South Coast.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

After landing into Liverpool the tour will end and members will part ways.

The ferry crossings assume a car with dimensions of a maximum of 6.5 metres in length and 1.8 metres in height. If your car exceeds these dimensions, a supplement may be payable – please enquire before booking.
