



SALVADORI CUP

For World Championship sports cars and production sports-racing cars of a type that raced between 1955 and 1960

Race length:	20 minutes
Circuit length:	2.38 miles
Licensing status:	National A Race
Scheduled:	Sunday 18 March

1) RACE ELIGIBILITY

The race is open to the following classification and categorisation of cars, as defined by Articles 2 and 3 of Appendix K:

Period E – Sports-racing cars built between 1/1/1947 and 31/12/1960

IMPORTANT NOTES

For the purposes of this race, Listers should run 16-inch, not 15-inch, wheels.

2) TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

The technical regulations for the Salvadori Cup are compliant with Appendix K of the International Sporting Code of the FIA. Goodwood also draws your particular attention to the following clarifications:

3) HISTORIC TECHNICAL PASSPORT

3.1 All competing cars must have a Historic Technical Passport, and a copy of the front page must be provided along with the completed entry form.

3.2 At any time during the event, competitors **must** be able to produce the full passport for inspection if requested to do so by Goodwood's Eligibility Scrutineers.

4) PRESENTATION

4.1 Goodwood requires a specific standard of aesthetic vehicle presentation, namely that all competing vehicles feature an appropriate period livery and detailing.

4.2 No out-of-period wheels, lighting, wing mirrors or dashboard gauges should be used, nor windows of an inappropriate material featuring out-of-period ventilation holes or flaps.

4.3 Externally-mounted onboard cameras are not permitted.

4.4 Where a competitor in an open car decides for safety reasons to use a roll-over bar, please ensure that it is sensitively installed to be as visually unobtrusive as possible.

4.5 Contrary to Article 2 of Appendix K, during the Members' Meeting no advertising, logos or graphics may appear on any vehicle unless these formed part of the car's original livery during racing prior to 1966.

5) SAFETY

5.1 For clarification on requirements for safety items such as fire extinguishers, roll cages and safety belts, please refer to Article 5 of Appendix K.

5.2 An FIA or MSA compliant rain light

5.3 All cars must be fitted with two external rear-facing mirrors, of a type in keeping with the car's period appearance. Mirrors will be inspected before each session to check functionality.

6) TYRES

6.1 Cars must only use Dunlop Vintage or 'L' section racing tyres which have 204 compound only and tread pattern CR65 or earlier.

6.2 Tyre sizes are free as long as all other relevant regulations (rims, etc) are respected. Tyre compounds must be underlined in yellow on the tyre sidewall.
