



Goodwood Motor Circuit 'Corona Secure' measures

1. The Motor Circuit will remain closed to the general public, only attendees of the track activity will be given access.
2. A marshal will be positioned at the Main Gate, on arrival drivers / riders should give their name and access will be given.
3. Drivers / riders should proceed straight to the paddocks area. Alternate paddock shelters will be cordoned off to ensure attendees can maintain social distancing whilst preparing their cars / bikes.
4. The sign-on desk will be positioned so attendees can sign-on without needing to enter the Jackie Stewart Pavilion. A queuing system will be in place to ensure social distancing.
5. All briefings will take place outside, either in front of the Pit Lane Office or under the pit lane depending on weather.
6. Toilets for guests will be available by the Richmond Lawn. Toilets are thoroughly cleaned prior to each day commencing and throughout each day.
7. All communal areas will be cleaned thoroughly prior to attendee's arrival and throughout the day.
8. Until current restrictions are lifted, passengers will not be permitted in track vehicles.
9. Car helmets are available for hire. They will be provided with cleaning equipment and a disposable helmet liner; however, attendees are strongly encouraged to bring their own helmet.
10. Multiple drivers can use one track vehicle provided attendees follow current guidelines on vehicle cleaning between drivers.
11. A very limited number of guests of drivers / riders are permitted but please be aware there are no covered viewing areas or catering outlets available.
12. Social distancing must be maintained at all times to ensure the safety of all guests and staff at Goodwood Motor Circuit.
