Routes and Car Parks

Please do not follow your sat nav to get to the Goodwood Revival. Event signs will help you to find the correct car park as indicated within this guide, and we ask you to show respect for local residents by only using advised routes.

Main Routes

Public Car Parks

If you do not have an allocated car park label, please follow the Public Parking map, which will show you the correct public routes to get to the most convenient car park.

Allocated Car Parking

If you have pre-booked and have an allocated car park label for Lavant Bank Parking or for the Revival Car Show, please follow the Allocated Parking map.


Disabled Car Parking and Motorcycles




Arriving after 1530

Main Route Information

From the North

Visitors from London should follow the A3 (M25 Junction I0) south towards Guildford. At Milford Junction, take the A283 turn-off towards Petworth. At Petworth, take the A285 towards Chichester and follow event signs. Alternatively, take the A286 via Midhurst and follow event signs.

From East/West

Visitors approaching
Goodwood from the
direction of either
Southampton or Brighton
should take the A27 towards
Chichester and then follow
the event signs.

From North-East

Those heading to
Goodwood from a northeast direction (Pulborough,
Horsham) should take the
A29 to the junction with
the A27 westbound
towards Chichester.

From North - West

Those arriving from a north-west direction (Petersfield, Basingstoke) should follow the A3 to the junction with the A27 eastbound.

Public car parks are free and open from 0700hrs each day. Parking is on grass and may not be suitable for low-slung vehicles. For information on other ways to get to the Goodwood Revival please contact our Ticket Office on 01243 755055.
