More recently in September, the Revival honoured Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, hosted the inaugural Revive & Thrive Village, and celebrated 10 years of the children's pedal car race, the Settrington Cup, in addition to three days of thrilling on-track action.

In 2023, the Festival of Speed will celebrate 30 years as *the* destination for innovation, technology and future mobility. The ever-popular Electric Avenue presented by pulse and Future Lab presented by Randox will remain at the heart of the spectacular event, which will also host legendary motorsport teams, drivers and riders from both past and present.
