INFORMATION FOR PILOTS OPERATING TO/FROM GOODWOOD AERODROME 09 MARCH - 08 MAY 2026

1 General

- 1.1 This circular provides information for pilots operating to/from Goodwood Aerodrome **09 March - 08 May 2026**. This period includes the construction and breakdown of an event site and a motor racing event.
- 1.2 All times in this circular are Universal Time Coordinated (UTC), which is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).
- 1.3 Published operational hours apply unless amended by NOTAM.
- 1.4 All passenger-carrying flights departing less than 15 minutes before the aerodrome closes must have an extension approved by the aerodrome in advance. All extensions are subject to staff availability.
- 1.5 Except for flights during the event, pilots to PPR by telephone by contacting ATS on 01243-755061.
- 1.6 Goodwood Information is on Channel 122.455.
- 1.7 The information in this circular is subject to change. Pilots should always consult the latest NOTAMs for the most accurate information.

2 The Event Site

- 2.1 The event site includes the apron, the manoeuvring area east of runway 14/32, the motor circuit, and land to the east of the aerodrome. The event site lies within an irregular four-sided area bounded by the following coordinates:
505156N 0004615W, 505117N 0004545W, 505112N 0004505W and 505145N 0004433W.
- 2.2 Site build **09 March – 17 April 2026**.
- 2.3 Motor racing event **18 – 19 April 2026**.
- 2.4 Site breakdown **20 April – 08 May 2026**.

3 Operational Restrictions

- 3.1 Temporary aircraft hangar obscures southern end of RWY 14/32 from ATS Unit view, resulting in Runway 14/32 reduced declared distances **09 March – 08 May 2026**.
- 3.2 Construction/dismantling of grandstands, marquees, fairground rides, and other temporary structures causes runway closures and restrictions on movement area east of Runway 14/32.
- 3.3 Runway 10/28 closed **30 March – 03 May 2026**.
- 3.4 Runway 06/24 closed **16 – 21 April 2026**.
- 3.5 Multiple cranes active across the event site during build and breakdown phases. Expect short-term runway closures and restrictions to operations outside published operational hours, as notified by NOTAM.
- 3.6 Flying outside published operational hours prohibited **12 - 22 April 2026**.
- 3.7 Aerodrome café closed **15 – 21 April 2026**.

4 The Motor Racing Event

- 4.1 83rd Members Meeting motor racing event – **Sat/Sun 18 - 19 April 2026**.
- 4.2 Operational hours **0630 – 1700**. Only helicopters permitted during the event.
- 4.3 Operators to obtain event booking and PPR number via -

- 4.4 Pilots in flight to provide their PPR number when requested by ATS.
- 4.5 Traffic information provided to pilots when relevant.
- 4.6 Inbound and outbound aircraft to report at:
 - The Trundle (505334N 0004514W) from the north;
 - Solar Panels (505145N 0004733W) from the west;
 - Point Sierra (505110N 0004344W) from the south-east.
- 4.7 Avoid arriving and departing in other directions.
- 4.8 Avoid overflying the following:
 - Motor circuit below 500 FT AGL / 620 FT AMSL;
 - Grandstands and temporary structures;
 - Eastern ends of Runways 06/24 and 10/28.
- 4.9 The intersection of Runways 06/24 and 14/32 (505136N 0004536W), referred to as 'the intersection', to be used for approaches and departures.
- 4.10 There is no marshalling/handling service. Pilots are responsible for parking and passenger safety.
