However, don't discount the other 13 drivers competing to be the Festival's mud-master. Each is committed to the point of defying gravity, which became abundantly clear this afternoon. As the third day of the Festival draws to a close amid torrential rain, these off-road monsters are in their element. If anything, they go faster...
