Kate McWilliams – Youngest Female Captain in the World

Kate McWilliams is an airline Captain for EasyJet. Her interest in flying started at an early age and she joined the Air Cadets aged 13. Six years later on her 19th Birthday, Kate joined pilot training school CTC Aviation to gain her commercial pilots licence. Aged just 21 Kate started working for EasyJet as a First Officer and in spring 2016, aged 26, she became EasyJet's youngest Captain and the world's youngest female Captain. Kate joins us at Goodwood to tell the story of her career journey so far and her challenge of addressing the gender imbalance in the flight deck.
